Self-isolation options

If you have received your final dose of a Health Canada-approved vaccine at least 14 days before entering Yukon you are not required to self-isolate. If you are able to verify your vaccine status, you can continue to go to work and into the community.

If you are arriving in Yukon and are not fully vaccinated, you must self-isolate for 14 days using one of these options.

1. Self-isolate alone or with your travel partners who are also self-isolating

You can self-isolate in your own home, or another suitable location. More information is available online.

2. Self-isolate with others who haven't travelled

If you choose this option, all unvaccinated household members must self-isolate with you for 14 days from the date that you arrive. Fully vaccinated household members do not need to self-isolate. Travelers must continue to follow self-isolation requirements (separate bedroom, avoiding contact, enhanced hygiene practices, etc.).

Faith-based services, indoors and outdoors

Camps and recreational programs

Camp and recreational programs can now have 20 participants indoors with physical distancing and masking and 100 outdoors with physical distancing.

Social bubbles

You should still limit your social bubble to 5 households, but the maximum number of people in the bubble has increased to 20.
