

# COVID-19 Fully Vaccinated Status in Yukon

In Yukon, an individual is considered fully vaccinated if they have received:

1. The full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada<sup>i</sup> and the final dose of COVID-19 vaccine was administered at least 14 days ago.
2. A complete COVID-19 vaccine series not authorized by Health Canada, but approved by the World Health Organization<sup>ii</sup>, and the final dose of COVID-19 vaccine was administered at least 14 days ago.

<sup>i</sup> The COVID-19 vaccines currently authorized by Health Canada are Pfizer-BioNtech, Moderna, AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson)

<sup>ii</sup> As of Nov 30<sup>th</sup> 2021, the Government of Canada is accepting the following WHO approved vaccines Bharat Biotech (Covaxin, BBV152 A, B, C), Sinopharm BIBP (BBIBP-CorV), Sinovac (CoronaVac, PiCoVacc). There are other vaccine products that are currently pending WHO approval and do not meet this criteria.
