

COVID-19 Fully Vaccinated Status in Yukon

In Yukon, an individual is considered fully vaccinated if they have received:

- 1. The full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canadaⁱ and the final dose of COVID-19 vaccine was administered at least 14 days ago.
- 2. A complete COVID-19 vaccine series not authorized by Health Canada, but approved by the World Health Organizationⁱⁱ, and the final dose of COVID-19 vaccine was administered at least 14 days ago.



[†] The COVID-19 vaccines currently authorized by Health Canada are Pfizer-BioNtech, Moderna, AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson)

[&]quot;As of Nov 30th 2021, the Government of Canada is accepting the following WHO approved vaccines Bharat Biotech (Covaxin, BBV152 A, B, C), Sinopharm BIBP (BBIBP-CorV), Sinovac (CoronaVac, PiCoVacc). There are other vaccine products that are currently pending WHO approval and do not meet this criteria.
