

YUKON SCIENTISTS AND EXPLORERS ACT (RSY 2002, C.200)

APPLICATION FOR LICENCE

General terms and conditions

- 1. Licences are generally valid only in the calendar year in which issued. Applications for extension should be submitted in the same manner as the original.
- 2. The licence holder shall provide written reports as specified on the licence.
- 3. A person designated may at any time inspect a licence, or any project being conducted under licence, including records or materials recovered.
- 4. The licence holder shall conform to all requirements that may be imposed by the institution designated as the recipient of the materials recovered.
- 5. The licence holder shall strictly observe all applicable Territorial and Federal legislation and regulations.
