### General terms and conditions

1. Licences are generally valid only in the calendar year in which issued. Applications for extension should be submitted in the same manner as the original.
2. The licence holder shall provide written reports as specified on the licence.
3. A person designated may at any time inspect a licence, or any project being conducted under licence, including records or materials recovered.
4. The licence holder shall conform to all requirements that may be imposed by the institution designated as the recipient of the materials recovered.
5. The licence holder shall strictly observe all applicable Territorial and Federal legislation and regulations.
